Group Questions

What a morning to celebrate how Jesus has changed people's lives and their choice to follow Him. It's amazing to see what God is doing. Baptism is also a time for all of us to reflect on the death and resurrection of Jesus, and celebrate the freedom He brings us.

Scripture: Matthew 3:13-17 Matthew 28:18-20, Romans 6:3-5

Bottom line: Baptism is an outward expression of an inward transformation.

Discussion Questions

1. What baptism story really resonated with you or spoke to you from Sunday? Why do you think it spoke to you?
2. Read Matthew 3:13-17. What surprises you about this passage of scripture? Why do you think Jesus would choose to be baptized early in his ministry? Why would he be baptized at all?
3. Read Romans 6:3-5. If you had to explain to someone who had never been to church what baptism is, what would you say?
4. Read Matthew 28:18-20. Why do you think Jesus makes baptism a requirement? Of all the things he could have said as parting words--why this?
5. Take a moment to look back on your life. In what areas are you grateful that God has transformed you? Where is he changing you now? Where would you like to see God work in your life?
